## Dogie Days Coming Up

## Clean Up Dumas Day Set for June 26

A clean-up day for Dumas is scheduled for Saturday, June 26. Last year's successful clean-up day in October is hoped to be duplicated at this summer's project. Over one ton of trash was picked up during the three-hour clean-up last October. This was accomplished by over 200 people.
