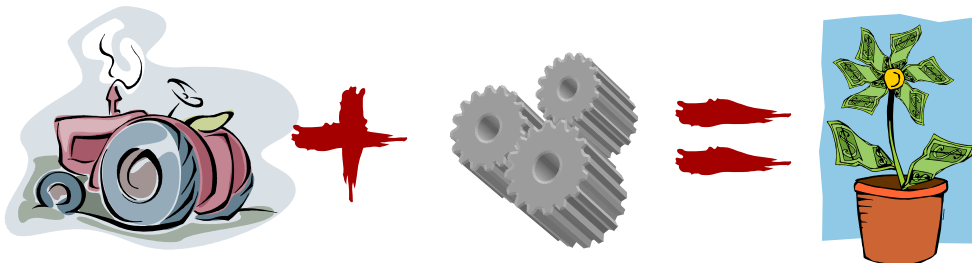
pected audience of 300 attendees.
