FLY-IN OCTOBER 13

Like airplanes? Here is your chance to see various aircraft up close at the Chamber's Fly-In scheduled for Saturday, October 13.

The event will be held at the Moore County Regional Airport and the Chamber is proud to partner with the airport on this event. Not only will the public get to see airplanes but the airport will be showcased also.

A B-25 bomber will arrive at the airport on Monday, Oc-

tober 8. As a prelim to the actual event. A WWII airplane, the B-25 will be on display through October 11. The plane is part of the Commemorative Air Force Wing, Mesa, Arizona.

Flights on the B-25 Can be arranged for \$395 per person.

Another airplane which will be on display during Saturday's event is a twin engine Beechcraft Model 18. This is a WWII cargo plane from Guymon, Oklahoma.

Volunteers from Dumas High School's Project Graduation will be offering a hamburger lunch for \$5 that day.

A few contests will take place among the aircraft pilots such as a flour sack bombing and spot landings.

The Fly-In is scheduled from 9 a.m.—1p.m.
